What can you DO if you are threatened?

In acute danger

please contact the police directly

Home expulsion

In acute danger, the police have the ability to remove the offender from the home and to prohibit him/her from returning.

The Protection Against Violence Act (Gewaltschutzgesetz – GewSchG)

offers you – on request to the Local Court (Amtsgericht) – the following ways to protect yourself against further violence:

- Assignment of an apartment
 The Court can assign the dwelling to you alone for a certain period of time.
- Prohibition of contact and injunction to stay away from the victim
 The Court can prohibit the offender
 - from entering the home,
 from approaching you and from contacting you.

What can you **DO** if you have problems with violence?

Contact the Intervention Center for Men; they will help you to learn how to live without violence.



Counselling is free, confidential and, if you wish, anonymous.

If necessary, an interpreter can be involved.

Important note:

You can contact the intervention centers at any time. You need not wait until police action has occurred.

For a home WITHOUT Violence

You can DO something if you are exposed to violence and need not accept it if your partner or your family

- insults or humiliates you,
- hits or threatens you,
- prevents you from leaving the house,
- keeps you from meeting family or friends,
- forces you to have sex,
- does not accept that you have separated or want to separate,
- stalks, harasses or terrorizes you,
- threatens you with marriage against your will,
- takes decisions which determine your plans for the future.

- anger and frustration have prevailed again,
- your good intentions have failed again.
